"According to research, Test scores improved by 17.3% for students regularly engaged in chess classes, compared with only 4.6% for children participating in other forms of enriched activities," states 4-time World Champion Susan Polgar in a recent interview. In approximately 30 nations across the globe, including Brazil, China, Venezuela, Italy, Israel, Russia and Greece, etc., chess is incorporated into the country's scholastic curriculum. Just as athletics are a part of the required agenda at schools in the United States, Chess has been that way in the European Nations abroad.

Other important points:

- ❖ Chess Club members will need to bring a note from a parent each Thursday to inform their homeroom teacher that they will be meeting the Chess Club parent helper in the junior high lobby after school (it will be Mrs. Carballo or another parent). Chess club members may bring a small snack to eat. Water bottles will be provided.
- ❖ It will prove beneficial for our novice players to learn the names of the chess pieces before starting in the club so that the instructions are easier to understand. Some excellent books at your public library or the Internet are good places to look for this basic information.
- ❖ Each week's meeting will consist of 20 minutes of review, 20 minutes of new material (lesson) & 20 minutes of playing. Chess sets, boards and handouts will be provided as part of the fee for joining the club. Members need only bring their attentive self.
- ❖ Chess-Now Ltd. from Glen Ellyn (www.chess-now.com) will be doing the instruction and has a tremendous reputation for working with young chess players. Mr. Jim Egerton has coached many SJA students in years past including Doug Jennings, Mitchell Kinn, Nick Carballo & Danny Sobolewski in addition to the SJA students who participated in Chess Club over the past two years at SJA.
