Characters:

Peter- The eldest of the four children. Brother to Susan, Edmund, and Lucy. Given a shield and a sword by Father Christmas. The high King of Narnia.

Susan- The eldest girl, sister to Peter, Edmund, and Lucy. Given a magical horn by Father Christmas. Also given a bow and arrows by Father Christmas.

Edmund- A traitor to Aslan at first but soon switched sides. Youngest brother, often picked on by Peter. Brother to Peter, Susan, and Lucy.

Lucy- The youngest of the four children and the first to enter Narnia through the wardrobe. Given a healing potion by Father Christmas. Sister to Peter, Susan, and Edmund.

Ivy- A servant under Mrs. Macready that doesn't come into the story much.

Margaret- A servant under Mrs. Macready that doesn't come into the story much.

Betty- A servant under Mrs. Macready that doesn't come into the story much.

Mrs. Macready- The head of the servants, a very strict woman.

The Professor- An old man who lived in a very old house that the four children went to during the air raids. It was he who first believed Lucy.

Tumnus- The Faun that Lucy first met when she entered Narnia, was later arrested when Edmund told the White Witch that he had met Lucy and had not reported her. He was then turned to stone, but later revived by Aslan.

The White Witch- The main villain of the story. The reason that Narnia had been forever winter and never Christmas. Born of giants and Adam's first wife, Lilith. Has magical Turkish Delight that enslaves Edmund.

Maugrim- The head wolf security under the White Witch.

Mr. Beaver- The beaver that helps Lucy, Peter, and Susan escape to meet Aslan.

Mrs. Beaver- Wife of Mr. Beaver, helps the children escape and tries to bring all of her possessions with them when they leave the house.

Aslan- The leader of Narnia, sends a feeling of goodness up the spines of the righteous and a feeling of horribleness up the spine of the wicked. Sacrificed himself to save Edmund. A great lion.

Lilith- Adam's first wife.

Father Christmas- Came to Narnia after the White Witch had kept him out for so long, gave gifts to each of the four children.
